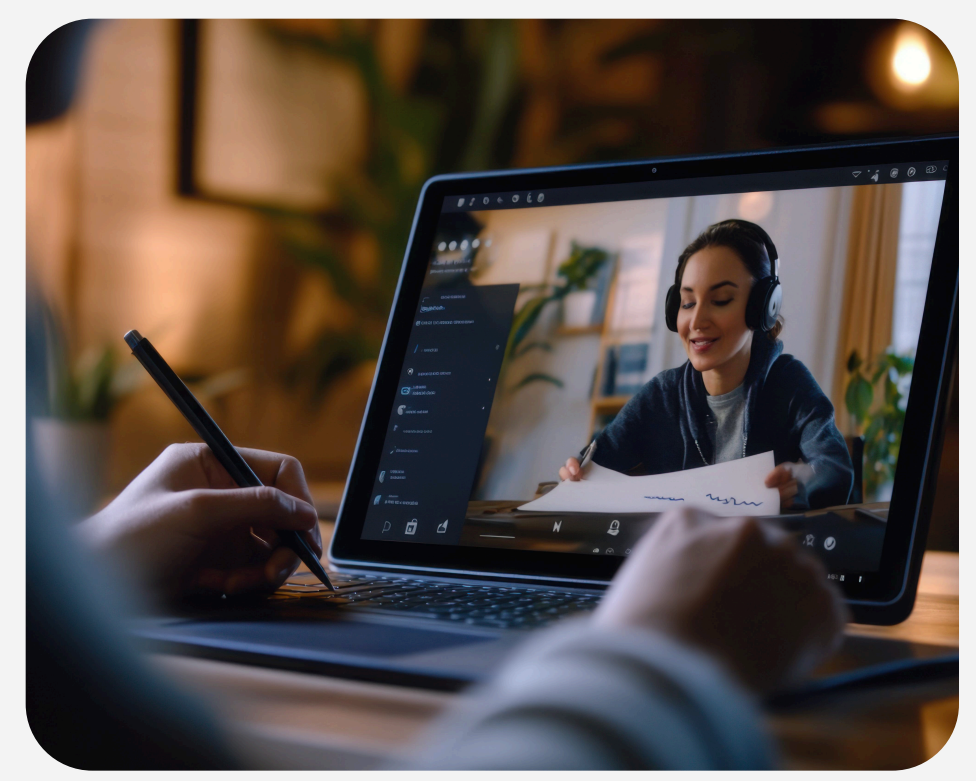
E-learning Platform
